#### **Precautions and maintenance**

- For indoor use only



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## 1 Product Diagram

### 1.1 Remote Control



- 1. **POWER-**Power On/Off
- 2. **MUTE** —Press Mute button to silence the voice temporarily.
- 3. **MENU**—Press to enter "Info Bar" when playing pictures or videos, or show the menu for copy / delete function in file interface
- 4. **RETURN**-- Return to the previous page
- 5. ◀ Functional selection button from right to left cursor
- 6. Functional selection button from left to right cursor
- 7. **SETUP**—Press setup to enter the setup page directly
- 8. **BGM--** In slideshow mode, press this button to add background music
- 9. **VOL -**—Turn down the volume
- 10. **ZOOM** In single picture mode, press to magnify picture display size
- 12. **ROTATE** In single picture mode, press to revolve the picture 90° in clockwise every time
- 13. **DISPLAY MODE** —In the picture mode; press this button to select the picture display mode 16:9 or 4:3 directly
- 14. ▲— Functional selection button from the bottom to the top cursor.
- 15. ►II Play/pause: In the playing mode, press this button, it will pause; repress this button, it will play again.
- 16. \(\neg \) Functional selection button from the top to the bottom cursor.

## 2. Installing & Replacing the Battery

Place the upside of the remote control down, press down on the ridged area of the battery cover and pull towards you to remove the tray. Place one CR2025 lithium button-cell battery on the tray with the positive "+" side facing you. Reinsert the tray.



## 3. Getting Started

3.1 Extend the digital photo frame bracket on the back of the frame to the widest position for greatest stability, and then plug one end of the included AC adapter into a standard 110-240V AC electrical outlet and the other end into the right side the frame.

**Note:** There are different positions for the digital photo frame stand. Please refer to "Stand Instruction".


- 3.2. Remove the protective film covering the LCD.
- 3.3. Remove the plastic battery insulator from the battery compartment and make sure the remote control has a battery inside. Please refer to "Installing & Replacing Battery" if you need a new battery.
- 3.4. Power on the unit by pressing the Power button on the remote control.

#### 4.1 Card and USB



**Note:** 1) Make sure there are supported picture, music and video files in the Card or USB device.

2) If there are supported picture and music files in the Card or USB Device, slideshow will play automatically with background music.

### **4.2 Picture Mode**



## **Copy & Delete function**



In single-picture mode, use 

to select the picture you want to copy to the built-in memory, then press MENU to enter copy interface, press 

to confirm.



In six-picture mode, use ◀ ▶ to select the picture you want to delete in the built-in memory, then press **MENU** to enter delete interface, press **★** to confirm.



Press **SLIDE SHOW** or **BGM** to start slideshow, and then press **MENU**, there will crop up a menu (single window/ four windows/tripe windows), use ▲ ▼ to choose the slide mode, then press ★ to display the pictures in the selected slide mode before.

#### 4.3 Music Mode

Press **RETURN** to choose "MEMORY CARD "in the main menu. Choose **Music**, then press ★ to enter the music interface. Press ▼to select.



When you enter the music interface, press▲▼ to select the music you want to play, and press ◄ to operate. Press VOL+/- to turn up/ down the volume.

#### **Delete function**



Use ◀ ▶ to select the music you want to delete, then press **MENU** to enter delete interface, press **◄** to confirm.

## 4.4 Video Mode



When you enter the video interface, press ▲▼ to select the video you want to play, and press ◄ to operate. Press VOL+/- to turn up/ down the volume.

### **Delete function**



Use ◀ ▶ to select the video you want to delete, then press **MENU** to enter delete interface, press **◄** to confirm.

### 5. File



#### **Delete**



Use ▲▼ to select the file you want to delete, then press **MENU** to enter delete interface, press **★** to confirm.

## 6. Calendar



Select **Calendar** from the main menu, press **OK** to enter, use ▲ ▼ to show the next/previous year of the calendar, use ▼ to show the last / next month of the calendar. In this mode, press **★** to add background music.

**NOTE:** When you enter the picture, music, video, file or calendar interface, just press **CARD SELECT** on the remote control to choose memory card quickly if there are two or more cards connected with the unit.

## 7. Setup



Press **Setup** from the main menu, and then press ★ to access to setup interface. Use ★▼to select the item you want to set up. Press ► to show the sub menu, select with ★▼, then press ★ to confirm.

7.10 Clock Setup

Set time format: 12/24, Press ▲▼ to set, use ◄ to confirm

Set Alarm: Press , use ▲▼ to choose on/off, then Press again, and use ▲▼ to set the alarm time.

- **7.11 Auto Power On/Off**: Press **OK**, choose setup items with ▲▼ as follows: Hour, Minute, Status, press **OK**, use ▼ to set, Press **OK** to confirm.
- **7.12 Format built-in memory**: Press **OK**, choose No/ Yes with ▲▼, Press **OK** to confirm
- **7.13 Reset setting**: Press **OK** enter, use ▲▼to select or unselect to reset all settings to default values, press **OK** to confirm.

7.14 Exit: Press to exit setup interface

#### 8. Stand Instruction

Extend the bracket from the slot of the digital photo frame, rotate the bracket until it is locked in place, and then revolve the bracket to choose standing horizontally or vertically. Please refer to the illustration shown below.
